

FREE THEATRE PROGRAM FOR YOUR SCHOOL

Dear Teacher,

We would like to invite you and your students to participate in Belvoir's theatre access program for students.

Belvoir's Theatre Enrichment program assists teachers seeking to give senior English students an introduction to theatre in order to prepare them to write about play texts in production in their HSC. The program equips students with the understanding and interpretative tools to engage with live theatre – and to discuss and write about it more effectively.

What is involved? There are three elements to the program:

- A pre-performance visit to your school by Belvoir to assist students in preparing to see a Belvoir production. Read more about Belvoir's productions <u>here.</u>
- 2. Attending a school matinee performance in **Term One, Term Two** or **Term Four 2017** at Belvoir St Theatre, free of charge (including a travel subsidy of up to 50% of approved travel for regional schools).
- 3. A post-performance visit to your school by Belvoir and artists to assist student reflection on the experience of seeing the production.

Who can participate? The program is designed for Year 11 English students with limited experience of live theatre. It also suits Year 10 & 11 Drama students with limited theatre experience.

What plays can you and your students see? A new Australian play <u>Mark Colvin's Kidney</u> (writer Tommy Murphy, director David Berthold); the critically acclaimed <u>Mr Burns</u> (writer Anne Washburn, director Imara Savage) or the new Lally Katz play <u>Atlantis</u> (director Rosemary Myers)

What teachers have said about the program "The students have asked to go again. Students love the pre-show intro to the play and asked if I could introduce all of their texts in this way!!"

"This program enables students to visualise techniques that otherwise would be read from a written version and described verbally. They can now apply their experience to what is discussed in class."
