Our aim is to support Young Belvoir Theatre Club members in becoming independent theatre-goers. Young Belvoir Club members will be encouraged to act as ambassadors for Belvoir in their communities and share their experience of our productions with their networks.

- A free ticket to six productions at Belvoir, each on the first Wednesday 6.30pm performance of the season, dates listed below (tickets non-transferrable).
- The opportunity to discuss the show afterwards with the actors, Belvoir staff and other Young Belvoir Theatre Club members.
