



COVID-SAFE INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

VIEWING ARCHIVES AT BELVOIR

Belvoir is a registered COVID-Safe business, and our procedures follow strict guidelines set by the NSW State Government and Live Performance Australia.

CHECK-IN

On arrival all teachers, students and other adults accompanying the group will be asked to sign in via the Service NSW app.

VACCINATION

All Belvoir staff members are required to be double vaccinated, including Belvoir admin staff who meet and greet students.

We will only ask students viewing an archival recording in person with their school, for proof of vaccination when required by NSW Public Health Orders. Currently, students viewing an archive at Belvoir, either with their school or individually, will not be required to show proof of vaccination.

Students attending a performance at Belvoir will need to comply with our vaccination requirement for audience members. All audience members above the age of 16 must have received 2 doses of an authorised COVID-9 vaccine. Vaccination status will be checked at the door and patrons who are not fully vaccinated will not be able to enter the venue.

MASKS

Under current NSW Public Health Orders, students, teachers and Belvoir staff will be required to wear masks during an archival viewing.

SANITISE

Hand sanitiser will be provided in the workshop space and at multiple points in the building

EQUIPMENT

Playback equipment will be set up by Belvoir Education in the space. Any equipment, such as remotes for volume will be sanitised and placed on the table for the teacher to use and directed to leave this equipment on their table at the end of the viewing.

Belvoir will continue to follow the latest NSW Government's COVID-19 advice and requirements to keep you safe.

VIEWING SPACE

Belvoir uses 100% fresh air from outside the theatre, which is then cooled or heated and distributed through the building in our air-conditioning. In many buildings a mixture of fresh and recycled air is used for climate control. By using 100% fresh air Belvoir reduces the risk of COVID circulating inside the building.

Participants are seated at tables or on chairs to view the archive, these will be set at an appropriate distance from each other, where possible. The capacity of these spaces is strictly limited by the 4 square metre rule. Please maintain 1.5m social distancing wherever possible.

REGULAR CLEANING

Belvoir has implemented a more intensive daily cleaning regime at the theatre, and our staff do regular additional cleaning of high-touch surfaces during, before, and after each performance including railings, door handles, lift buttons, toilet and cubicle locks, chair backs and tabletops.

Prior to the commencement of the viewing Belvoir Education staff will wipe down all table surfaces and chair edges, as well as high traffic areas such as handrails.

INDUCTION

At the beginning of the viewing Belvoir Education will remind participants of the following:

- Maintain physical distance from other participants
- Sneeze or cough into your elbow
- Avoid unnecessary contact with other participants
- Move your own chair if required
