

Accessible Light Sensitivity Guide

At Belvoir, we take accessibility and audience wellbeing seriously. We want you to know in advance where strobing occurs so you can make informed choices about your experience. Below is a breakdown of the strobing effects in the last twelve minutes of the production.

Please note: Strobe lighting and strobing effects can affect people who are sensitive to light, including those with epilepsy, migraine, or sensory sensitivities. If you are concerned, please feel free to speak to our Front of House team before the show begins — they are here to support you.

When Strobing Begins

Strobing occurs when the pictured character (Orlando 4) steps on stage during the final section of the play (Act 4). From this moment until the end of the production (approximately 12 minutes), strobes are used in timed bursts during transitions.



Breakdown of Strobing Effects

Overall, there are 20 strobing sections and 20 scenes between the lighting effects. Most of the strobing sections are between 7-9 seconds. With them getting longer towards the end.

Every light effect is accompanied by the sound of a train.
